Parents,

Summer is almost done! It makes me sad but also excited to be starting a new school year.

We will be having a parent orientation night on Thursday, August 31st from 7 to 8:30. We ask that this be a 'child-free' evening.

I have attached the state required paperwork, information on what to bring, and the 2017-2018 calendars. One of the things to bring is an earthquake kit and if you are a returning family, we have placed last year's kit either in your child's cubby or near it for you to ensure all the items will not expire prior to the end of the school year.

If you need to fill out any of the paperwork you can print, fill out and then bring it prior to or on the parent orientation night. Typically, only new families will need to fill out all the state required paperwork. If you have been attending, we have the necessary paperwork and the only thing we would need would be updated emergency contacts and updated immunization if they have changed.

If your child has any allergies, please reply to this email so we make sure we let the classroom teachers know.

If your child will be napping, you will need to purchase a bedding bag and cot sheet. You can come in prior to the start of school and pick up them so you can wash your sheet and have the bag packed to put in your child's cubby at the parent orientation night. You might also want to bring the bag of extra clothing. Each child needs a blue Trinity Lutheran Preschool t-shirt so if you don't have one, please stop in the office to pick one up.

Since we have two pre K classes we divide the student based on parent requests, the number of boys and girls, and the number of half day and full day students. I will be sending out a separate email to the PreK parents showing which class the children have been placed. If there are any concerns about the class your child has been placed in, please contact me. We do not have much flexibility but I will do my best explain our reasoning and if possible adjust the placement.

Thank you for choosing our school. We look forward to getting to know new students and parents as well as welcoming our returning families. There will be more informational emails prior to the start of school, one of which will give you the new gate code. I use emails as my main means of communication but sometimes we also put notices by the sign in sheets. There are also two bulletin boards by the entrance gate outside Room 4 that are parent information boards.
